Time Requirements

- Participate in the materials load-in and all counselors training session on Saturday, August 8, from 9:00 a.m. until noon at the Asian American Resource Center.
- Participate in camp, August 10–14, 2015 from 8:30 to 3:00 and at the Friday evening dinner for families starting at 6:00 and ending no later than 9:00.

These sessions are required. If the applicant has conflicts, then s/he should not apply.

Job Description

- Each of the five levels of classes will have a 1:5 ratio of counselors who guide that class through the weeklong sessions, breaks, lunch, and all other activities throughout the week. This year, we will have 130 kids, ages 5–13 years old on the roster, divided into nine classes.
- The contracted college counselors will be responsible for being the constant adult for the students in their group and the high school assistant counselors will help the teachers and volunteers as they lead their portions of the camp.
- In addition, all counselors may lead some activities such as chopstick races, Chinese yo-yoing, reading a story, craft-making, etc. We may have a pool of assistant counselors who will host several "centers" that will feature one element of Chinese culture and all classes will move through each activity. These counselors will remain and teach at the centers all week.
- Each camp day, Families with Children from China will provide a light breakfast, ongoing coffee or tea, full lunch, and Friday night dinner.
- After camp, and with plenty of notice, the camp directors will happily complete any requested paperwork needed to document the service hours earned during this experience. Camp directors may also serve as references.
